Job Title: Evaluator Advocate/Evaluation Project Lead¹

Job Summary: With a commitment to the mission and vision of BECOME, this position is responsible for leading and managing evaluation projects, applying a Culturally Responsive Evaluation framework and using evaluation as a tool for social justice and thriving communities. The Evaluator Advocate is charged with rigorous evaluation design and implementation, ensuring the values of BECOME are infused throughout evaluation and community engagement processes. Utilizing quantitative and qualitative data analytics to support and drive content creation, this position subsequently partners with served communities, systematically evaluating programs' added value.

Essential Job Functions, Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Design evaluation projects.
- 2. Develop and maintain protocols to measure and ensure quality.
- 3. Collect quantitative and qualitative data and analyze.
- 4. Engage community members/program participants in evaluation processes.
- 5. Attend served-community events, documenting programming effectiveness.
- 6. Write, produce and deliver comprehensive reports.
- 7. Deliver required and requested program updates during scheduled and "called" project meetings.

Education: Bachelor's degree in Evaluation, Business, Psychology, Social Work/Human Services or related field of study.

Related Experience: At least two years of experience.
